We ask you to think seriously before signing up for the Fine Arts Academy. The Fine Arts Academy is designed to accommodate students who:

1. Have a keen interest in the arts and enjoy working in them
2. See themselves as potentially pursuing a career in the Fine Arts

In order for students to be successful in the Fine Arts Academy they need to have an excellent attitude, good work habits, and be well organized. The Fine Arts Academy is a program of choice, therefore a fee (yet to be finalized) will be charged to be in the program. Since the Fine Arts Academy is a "program of choice", students may be moved back into the regular program if it is clear they are experiencing problems with interest and effort in both academic and fine arts classes. Returning students who have had problems with attitude and effort (or have an outstanding school fee balance) may not be allowed to register in the Academy again.

Students who are very seriously involved in Fine Arts lessons outside of the school day (with a private instructor) are afforded extra flexibility when it comes to timetable programming. Students may elect to drop one of their Fine Arts classes, and use these "free" periods to take a lesson at school with their private instructor, leave the school to take a lesson, or practice material given to them by their private instructor. Please remember that practice space is limited at St. Mary's because of growing enrollment and thus will be allocated on a first come first served basis, once the timetable is completed in June.

It is very important for everyone to understand that these "free" periods are only available to students who are serious about their lessons outside of school. In order to access this time, students must be taking private lessons.
